

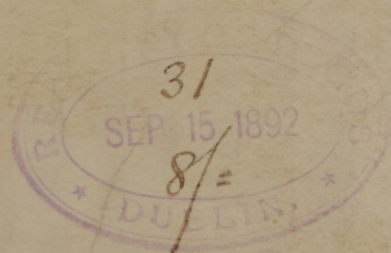

Agreement

made between William B. Homan Mulock of Bellair in the Kings County Esquire of the one part and Christopher Guinan also of Bellair aforesaid Farmer of the other part

Whereas the said Christopher Guinan holds a farm of land at Bellair on the Estate of the said William B. Homan-Mulock And Whereas the said Christopher Guinan has formerly been allowed to exercise a right of turbary and of drawing bog-stuff and of watering Cattle on that part of the bog or lands of Bellair lying South of the high road and adjoining Spring Park bog which right is not attached to or an easement appurtenant to his holding nor has the said Christopher Guinan any such legal rights or right having been merely permissive And Whereas the said William B. Homan-Mulock has agreed to give the said Christopher Guinan the sum of ten pounds to relinquish any supposed rights of turbary and of drawing bog stuff and watering cattle as heretofore on said bog or lands and thus avoid any possible future litigation Now the said Christopher Guinan in consideration of the said sum of ten pounds this day paid to him by the said William B. Homan Mulock (the receipt
